## **AST PROGRESSIVE**

The past progressive (or past continuous) is used for actions that were happening at a specific time in the past. Like the present continuous, it is formed with the auxiliary verb "to be" and the werb + ing.

To form the past progressive, the auxiliary verb "to be" and the verb + ing are used. The auxiliary werb "to be" is in the past simple, but keep in mind that "to be" is an irregular verb.

	STRUCTURE	EXAMPLES
AFFIRMATIVE	Sujeto + was / were + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)	When I saw them they were sitting at a café.
NEGATIVE	Sujeto + was / were + not + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)	What did you say? I wasn't listening.
INTERROGATIVE	Was / Were + sujeto + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)?	What were you talking about?
