

Solución

Ejercicios.

$$1. P(SA) = \frac{3}{6} = 0,5 \times 100 = 50\%$$

$$2. P(SA) = \frac{8}{52} = 0,153 \times 100 = 15,3\%$$

$$3. P(SA) = \frac{11}{52} = 0,211 \times 100 = 21,1\%$$

$$4. P(SA) = \frac{3}{6} = 0,5 \times 100 = 50\%$$

$$P(SB) = \frac{1}{3} = 0,3 \times 100 = 30\%$$

$$30\% \text{ de } 50\% = 15\%$$

$$5. P(SA) = \frac{4}{12} = 0,3 \times 100 = 30\%$$
