Negative: ~~Does~~ Juan ~~doesn't~~ play soccer every day?

Question: Does Juan play soccer every day?

Affirmative: I love my new car.

Negative: ~~I~~ ~~don't~~ love my new car.

Interrogative: ~~Do~~ I love my new car?

Affirmative: Peter and Walter travel to China.

Negative: ~~Peter and Walter~~ ~~don't~~ travel to China.

Interrogative: ~~Do~~ Peter and Walter travel to China?

Conjugate

Sara loves Kim

Sara doesn't love Kim

Sara and Peter don't eat hot dogs at mall

Sara and Peter don't eat hot dogs at mall
