Subject + auxiliary (negative) + verb (infinitive) + complement.

I don't study English. / I do not study English.

She doesn't study English. / She does not study English.

We don't study English. / We do not study English.

**Remember** = for I/you/we/they: \*DO

for she/he/it = DOES

## Question or Interrogative Form

**Affirmative sentences** = Juan plays soccer every day.

**Negative sentences** = Juan doesn't play soccer every day.

**Question**: Does Juan play soccer every day?

**Affirmative** = I love my new car

**Negative** = I don't love my new car

**Question**: Do I love my new car?

**Affirmative**: Peter and Walter travel to China

**Negative**: Peter and Walter don't travel to China

**Question**: Do Peter and Walter travel to China?
