

BE USED TO

If you are used to something, you have often done it or experienced it; it is not strange, new or difficult for you.

Structure: Be used to (some) + noun phrase or verb (-ing form)

We can also say be used to someone

Negative: be not used to.

I am used to speaking up early in the morning. I don't mind it.

He didn't complain about the neighbours' loud party - he was used to the noise.

EXAMPLES:

- Speak French I am used to speaking French
- Sleep early she is used to sleeping early
- Read a book per month - I am used to reading a book per month
- Play guitar - I'm used to playing guitar
- Travel Abroad - I'm used to travelling abroad
- Pay my Bills - I'm used to paying my bills
- Fight with my friend - I am used to going to the shop

GET USED TO

Structure

Get used to + something / someone

Get used to + verb (-ing form)

If you get used to something you become accustomed to it; it is no longer unusual or strange.

Get used to is the process of becoming used to something

Example:

She gets used to speaking French

Hein got used to sleeping early

I get used to read a book

He get used to play guitar

She get used to travel abroad

We get used to pay my bills

I get used to fight

USED TO

Used to + verb infinitive refers to a habit or state in the past. It is used only in the past simple tense

Past habits

If you used to do something, you did it for a period of time in the past, but you don't do it any more.

Past states

We also say used to express a state that existed in the past but doesn't exist now. States are NOT actions. We express states with stative verbs such as have, believe, know and like

- He is used to running very fast
- He get used to running very fast
- I used to run very fast

3 Eat hamburger

- Carlos is used to eaten hamburger
- Carlos get used to eaten hamburger
- Carlos used to eat hamburger

4 Drink water

- We are used to drinking water
- We get used to drinking water
- We used to drink water

5 Paint Animal

- Laura is used to painting animal
- Laura get used to painting animal
- Laura used to paint animal
