Must/mustn't

It is used to express necessity or give strong recommendation. It expresses prohibition in negative statements

Grammar Rules

Affirmative form:

NOUN + Modal verb + complement

We **Must** **Recycle** = we have an obligation to do it

Negative

NOUN + Modal verb + complement
