

Verb to be

The "to be" is a verb used to describe something or someone. The most common use of the to be verb is to talk about names, age, feeling, nationalities, and professions

Example

Name = My name **is** DiegoAge = I **am** 30 years oldFeeling = I **am** happyNationality = My nationality **is** ColombianProfession = My profession **is** teacher

Verb to be = Personal pronoun + Verb to be

I = am

You = are

She = is

He = is

It = is

We = are

You = are

They = are

Example • The cat is beautiful.

The doctor are tired.

They are tired.

Mary and Peter are boyfriends.

Mary is punctual.

Miguel is a vet.

Affirmative = She is happy.

Negative = (Not) She is not happy / She isn't happy.

Affirmative = We are engineers.

Negative = We are not engineers / We aren't engineers.

Affirmative = Peter is tall.

Negative = Peter is not tall / Peter isn't tall.

Affirmative = Sara is small.

Negative = Sara is not small / Sara isn't small.

Question = Is Sara small?

Affirmative = The students are wise.

Negative = The students are not wise / The students aren't wise.

Question = Are the students wise?

Question = Is the teacher elegant?

Answer (Affirmative) Yes, he is. / Yes the teacher is elegant.

Answer (Negative) No, he is not. / No the teacher is not elegant.

Affirmative = Walter is a baker.

Negative = Walter is not a baker / Walter isn't a baker.

Question = Is Walter a baker?

Answer (Affirmative) Yes, He is / Yes, Walter is a baker.

Answer (Negative) Not, He is not / Not, Walter isn't a baker.
