Answer (affirmative) yes he is / yes the teacher is elegant

Answer (negative) Not, he is not / Not the teacher is not elegant.

Affirmative: Walter is a baker.

Negative: Not he is not /

Question: is walter a baker?

Answer: yes he is / yes the walter is baker

Answer: no he is not / no the walter is not baker

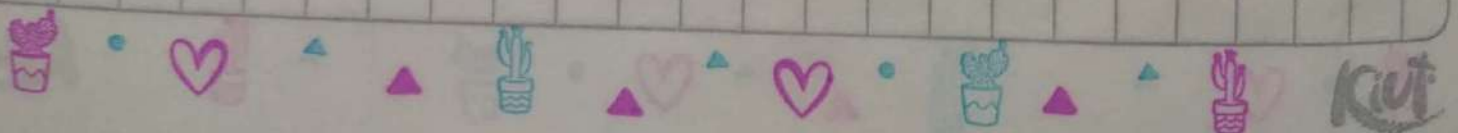
