### 1. Zero conditional

IF + present simple present  
simple.

### 2. First conditional

IF + present simple + will

### 3. Second conditional

IF + past simple, would (infinitive verb)

### 4. Third conditional

IF past perfect, would have  
(verb past participle form)

## Zero and First

### Conditionals

1. My teacher gets angry when I don't do my homework.

2. My little sister cries IF she will have a nightmare.

3. When you drink too much alcohol, you will get drunk.

4. IF you mix blue and yellow, you will get green.

5. IF you don't drink enough



water, you will become dehydrated.
